03 | DACA RENEWAL APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED BETWEEN 120-150 PRIOR TO EAD EXPIRATION DATE



04 | ADVANCE PAROLE TO TRAVEL ABROAD IS NO LONGER AVAILABLE TO DACA RECIPIENTS



05 | DECISION TO END DACA DOES NOT AFFECT IN-STATE TUITION OR SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY AT THE U
